- Source Supplies works to ensure, to the best of our knowledge that there is no child labour, modern slavery or human trafficking in our supply chains or in any part of our business. This includes suppliers, contractors and any other organisation with which we do business
- As part of our initiative to identify and mitigate risk we have procedures to:-
 - Identify and assess, and mitigate against, potential risk areas in our own business within our recruitment process and in our appointment of contractors, and;
 - Identify and assess, and mitigate against potential risk areas in our supply chains.
- On an annual basis, we will consider ways in which we can review and measure our success and effectiveness to ensure that child labour slavery and human trafficking is not taking place in any part of our business or supply chains.
- This policy is made under section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and constitutes our child labour, slavery and human trafficking statement for the financial year ending 31 December 2021.
